The foursome's best drive is used on each hole, and golfers play their own ball the rest of the way. The foursome's two best scores are counted for team competition. Format may change due to weather conditions.

Two Courses

The Classic takes place on Championship Course # 3 and Course # 1 — with separate team competitions and prizes for each course.

You'll be among the first to play on a new Course # 3, now being updated for the 2012 Ryder Cup. Due to renovations, no carts are permitted on Course # 3 during your round, but walking caddies will be provided. No exceptions will be made. On Course # 1, carts and fore-caddies are available.

Highlights

Play with the Pros: A professional will accompany each foursome on **Championship Course # 3**, playing his own ball for professional competition and assisting the foursome. Club pros are also available before play on the driving range and practice green—and at the evening reception.

Cool Competitions: Individual and team competitions are held, including multiple hole-in-one chances on each course to win cars and other valuable prizes.

Proceeds Benefit New Emergency Department Imaging Center

Rapid, state-of-the-art imaging in the Hospital's Emergency Department (ED) is often key to obtaining an accurate diagnosis and choosing the most effective treatment. With a stroke, it can mean the difference between life and death, between full recovery and debilitation. A large area on the new South Pavilion's first floor is reserved for a new ED Imaging Center. The Center is ideally located within the ED for fast imaging when timing is critical to saving lives, treating serious injuries

and minimizing long-term damage. But the cost of building out the space and fully equipping it with the most advanced technology is \$8.5 million, and NCH needs philanthropic support to complete the project without delay. For optimal care, the center must have two CT scanners, MR imaging, as well as ultrasound and digital radiography rooms. Proceeds from this year's Golf Classic will help construct and equip this life-saving space.
