A PASSION FOR HELPING OTHERS

How John and Rita Canning's philanthropy is changing healthcare and changing lives

Exactly 30 years ago, after John and Rita Canning had been making regular donations to various organizations, the couple sat down and made a conscious decision: they set out to be more intentional about their contributions - and get actively involved with the organizations.

The way John Canning remembers it, he said: "Why don't we each pick something that we're passionate about and get really involved with it."

His wife, Rita, finishes the thought: "We were emphatic that we each pick something different, and get actively involved rather than just write a check."

For John, that passion was making inner city education accessible, while for Rita it was about helping women and children, and in particular victims of domestic abuse.

At Northwest Community Hospital, they found a program that blends those interests:

a primary care clinic offering prenatal care for underserved women, that offers patient care and education, all the way through delivery at Northwest Community and follow-up postpartum care.

Now called the "Canning Model," this continuum of care began in 2016 in Wheeling, with the Cannings pledging the initial \$1 million

to launch the program. A year ago, the couple made another gift of \$1 million, this time to support a second clinic in Palatine.

Similar clinics had been tried before at NCH, but the stars aligned once the hospital found a partner in Greater Family Health - a federally qualified health center that started in Elgin - and a generous donor willing to cover the cost of the care not covered by Medicaid, the Cannings.

"The need is very real," John Canning says. "The hospital is providing subsidized care for people who really need it and they are implementing it well. It's running very efficiently."

In its first five years, Creekside Clinic in Wheeling served 1,435 women, with 7,757 visits and 665 deliveries at Northwest Community. 22% of the obstetric patients seen at the clinic were classified as high-risk for complications, which is a much higher percentage than average. Because of the proper prenatal care and intervention provided, only 7% of those high-risk deliveries resulted in any complications - a dramatic difference.

Last year, a ribbon cutting ceremony took place at the newly constructed Palatine location, and



the Cannings were there, proud to support a second clinic, they said, given the great success of the first one.

“Sadly, many of these women didn’t have access to the care they needed, but now they do, and children have a better start to life because of it,” Rita said at the dedication.

It was Dr. Henry Dominicis, retired co-founder of WomanCare Obstetrics & Gynecological Services in Arlington Heights and now Physician Director of Ambulatory Services at NCH, who brought the entities together. “Caring for the community takes committed cooperation,” he says simply.

“Many times, patients would show up at the emergency room at Northwest Community in labor, with no doctor,” Dr. Dominicis says. We had no access to their files and often they arrived with a complication.”

“We moved them up to labor and delivery, but once they went home, we had no way to follow up to ensure a positive outcome and access to ongoing care,” he adds. “This gave us a feel for the real need in the community.”

In opening the clinics in Wheeling and Palatine, and working with Greater Family Health, NCH providers and the philanthropic giving of the Cannings, Dr. Dominicis believes it is a model that can be duplicated in more urban areas.

David Ungorean, Executive Director for NCH Foundation also noted how this partnership extends beyond mother and baby as the Greater Family Health clinics become a medical home for the entire family. “Our amazing community health workers are also supported by the Cannings’ gifts. They are a critical component of the model and walk alongside the family to make sure they are connected to all the resources available to them – both medical and non-medical.”

“The Canning Model resulted from a combination of federal funds, private and hospital philanthropy, community health professionals and Northwest Community Hospital,” Dr. Dominicis says. “This orchestration of

resources promotes a healthcare model of quality, compassionate and sustainable healthcare for pregnant women and their families.”

The Cannings agree and say that kind of compassionate healthcare drew them to invest in the hospital. They already had a long history with NCH. One of their children was born there and they turned to the hospital for emergencies while raising their family. Rita’s parents lived in Arlington Heights, just two blocks from NCH and she regularly brought them to see their doctors there and to the hospital for treatment. Both Cannings now turn to NCH doctors for medical care.

Their philanthropy to NCH began in 2007 when the couple made their first \$1 million gift to help expand and renovate the emergency department, which opened right after the hospital’s new South Pavilion.

Over the last three years, they have also donated generously to provide holiday meals for patients of Greater Family Health in Wheeling and other area charities serving low-income families. As a result, between 400 to 500 families have enjoyed this special dinner annually.

Of course, with the growth of both clinics comes increased costs to run them and the Cannings encourage others in the community to become a partner.

“The way we see it, investing in our local hospital is a chance to get involved, see outcomes and see results,” Rita Canning says, “rather than just writing a check.”

John Canning finishes her thought, saying “We’re really involved in the hospital and interact with its people. They meet with us regularly to bring us up to date on our charitable investments. Overall, we’re extremely satisfied with how they continue to meet the needs of the community.”

A FAMILY CARING FOR THEIR COMMUNITY

Terry Cobry of Mount Prospect proudly wears his Loras College sweatshirt. But what he takes the most pride in is his wife, Esther, and her 33-year career as a registered nurse at Northwest Community Healthcare.

This mother of three had requested the 11 p.m.-7 a.m. shift because it let her practice her nursing skills that she worked so hard to acquire, allowed her to be a mom that saw her children off to school and let her be at home for their return from school.

"I expected that Esther would go to bed as soon as our children left for school," says Terry, 83, a retired career marketing administrator with IBM. "But she was a member of a morning bowling team!"

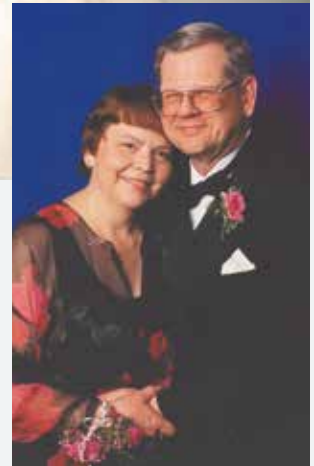
Esther began her career at Northwest Community in 1971 in the well-baby nursery, but within a few years she switched to the special care nursery, now called the Neonatal Intensive Care Unit.

"She had this quality about her that I admired. You couldn't rattle her cage," Terry says. "She was able to control her emotions. If a baby slipped into a crisis condition, she didn't panic but shifted into her professional mode."

"I couldn't be prouder of Northwest Community, because Esther spent most of her career there," Terry says.

Esther died in 2019 at the age of 77, from the effects of Alzheimer's disease. Yet even before she passed away the couple were regular contributors to the hospital, directing their contributions for upgrades to the nursery, Terry says.

Now widowed, Terry believes even more strongly in supporting his local hospital. He grew up in Des Plaines and only left the area to attend Loras College, located in Dubuque, Iowa. That's where



he met Esther, who earned her nursing degree from the Mercy School of Nursing, also in Dubuque.

The couple married in 1966, after Terry completed military service in the Navy, and they moved back to Des Plaines. After two years in an apartment, they bought their first home in Mount Prospect, where they raised their family.

Having a community hospital nearby, not only offered Esther Cobry a long and satisfying career, but it was there for their family needs.

"I've had surgery there twice and have had no problems," Terry says. "My doctors are excellent, and I rave about the hospital to anyone who asks."

One of things his wife enjoyed outside of her work in the nursery were the regular reunions the hospital would organize, bringing staff nurses together with their former patients from the NICU.

"Those reunions provided living proof that those times when the special care staff did their lifesaving jobs," Terry says, "it was for the benefit of all of us."

As for why he continues to donate to the hospital, Terry says it's simple: "I want to make sure it's there, not only for me, but for our community."
